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TENDERS TO BE INVITED BY PORT BONYTHON FUEL TERMINAL

The developer of the Port Bonython Fuel Terminal will soon begin the tendering process for the \$110 million project. The procurement strategy will be based on a select tender process by invitation.

'Tendering for Whyalla's next major development will begin in the final quarter of 2014', Mr. Yasuyuki Suzuki, Chief Executive Officer said.

'All tenders will be finalised by mid 2015.'

'Work packages will range in value between \$8 million and \$20 million.'

'Port Bonython Fuel Terminal will seek to maximise local participation in the project by directly engaging with contractors.'

'Construction and commissioning work will take about 18 months.'
